The County of San Diego - Department of Public Works is seeking qualified applicants for Assistant Engineer. Employees in this job classification perform professional civil or structural engineering work in the field and office. Under the general supervision of a Registered Professional Engineer, Assistant Engineers serve as either: 1) assistant resident engineers or resident engineers on capital improvement projects, or as inspectors on land development construction projects. Engineering tasks may include but not limited to: contract administration; construction inspection; stormwater permit monitoring and inspections; technical and financial analysis; engineering calculations; review and research; interpret and implement construction plans and specifications; prepare a variety of technical and administrative reports; and other duties as directed.

The current vacancy and future anticipated vacancies are located in the Department of Public Works –

Private Development Construction Inspection. This eligibility list may be used to fill future vacancies in other departmental divisions/sections.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. A bachelor's degree in civil or structural engineering from an accredited U.S. college or university, or a certified foreign studies equivalency with coursework approved by the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET); OR,
2. Engineer-in-Training (E.I.T.) certificate from State of California, and one (1) year of experience in civil or structural engineering.

Note: Possession of a Construction General Permit Qualified Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) Developer (QSD) and/or SWPPP Practitioner (QSP) from the California Stormwater Quality Association (CASQA) is highly desirable.
