Guidelines & Criteria Application

Purpose:

The Purpose of the Ramona Chamber of Commerce's Educational Program Grant (EPG) is to support RUSD programs that enhance the education, talents, skills, character, and community involvement of its students. Amount of grant award (minimum \$500) and number of grants will be at the sole discretion of the Ramona Chamber of Commerce.

Eligibility:

Programs and projects conducted by faculty within the RUSD are eligible. Programs and projects may take place before, during or after classroom hours and must have purposeful impact on at least a classroom of students and/or significant portion of the student body. Programs and projects may be wholly educational, or have a focus on artistic, athletic, or special skills development.

Criteria:

- Grant applications must be submitted by a faculty member no later than the second week in October of the school year to be considered for funding in that year. Grant application materials should be submitted to the: **Ramona Chamber of Commerce, 1306 Main St. Ste. 103, Ramona, CA 92065** by mail or via email to: **rcstaff@RamonaChamber.com**.
 - Applications must be completed and signed by the faculty program advisor.
 - Programs and projects must be approved by the RUSD to be conducted at a school site.
 - Grant applications must be submitted completely and include the signature page, project description, total project budget including the allocation of how EPG Funds will be used, and a brief summation of expected outcomes.
